On March 21, 2017 at about 9:49 AM, RBPD officers responded to a disturbance at Dog Island Park. When officers arrived, they found a 47 year old male with several dog bite wounds on both arms and one leg. Officers learned that male and a 31 year old male were involved in an altercation inside the park.

During the altercation, the 31 year old male walked away but was followed by the other male. The 31 year old male's dog then bit the other male. During that time, the 47 year old male stabbed the dog twice with a knife. The 47 year old was transported to the hospital for treatment regarding the dog bites.

The dog, a two year old male Pit Bull, died at the scene.

No arrests were made and the incident will be forwarded to the Tehama County District Attorney's Office for a complaint.
