SUMMARY:

On September 12, 2016 at about 330 A.M.,

Officers from the Red Bluff Police Department were dispatched to 1275 Walnut Street regarding a robbery that had just occurred. Upon their arrival, Officers contacted the 64 year old wheelchair bound victim who stated several minutes earlier, he was sleeping in his residence and woke up to smoke a cigarette. The victim went into his bedroom where he saw the suspect standing in his closet.

The suspect demanded money but the victim stated he did not have any. The victim then attempted to call 911 but the suspect took the victim's cell phone and broke it. The suspect stole the victim's cell phone and some cigarettes. The suspect was described as a white male adult in his early-mid twenties about 6' 2" tall and 160 pounds. The suspect had short hair and was wearing a blue and grey plaid shirt, blue undershirt and a red hat with a white diamond on it. The suspect also had a fixed blade knife in a brown sheath on the right side of his pants.

The suspect left the victim's apartment on foot in an unknown direction. The victim was not injured during this crime. Anyone with information regarding this case is urged to call the Red Bluff Police Department at 530-527-3131.
