**SUSPECT:** Lindsay Lang, 33 years, from Red Bluff  
**CRIME/INCIDENT:** Child molestation.  
**LOCATION:** 1000 Franklin Street, Red Bluff  
**DATE OCCURRED:** From August through October, 2016

#### **SUMMARY:**

On January 23, 2017:

A 14 year-old male victim was brought to the Red Bluff Police Department by his mother to report he was molested by 33 year-old, Lindsay Lang. Lang began having sexual relations with the boy shortly after his 14<sup>th</sup> birthday in August of 2016. Between August 2016 and October 2016 the victim reported 5 separate sexual encounters with Lang. During the 5<sup>th</sup> encounter the victim's 13 year-old male friend also participated in the sex acts. Lang is known to the first victim and it is not believed there are other victims at this time.

When confronted by the victim's mother, Lang agreed to turn herself in. When detectives learned Lang was at the Butte County Courthouse in Chico, the Butte County Sheriff was contacted and Lang was detained.

Lang was subsequently interviewed and arrested by Red Bluff Police and booked into the Tehama County Jail on numerous child molestation charges. Lang's bail was set at \$650,000.
