On January 10, 2018 at 1:35 PM, officers responded to St. Elizabeth's Community Hospital regarding a possible child abuse. Officers arrived and learned a 26 day old infant female had suffered a fractured upper arm (humerus).

Investigators from the Red Bluff Police Department along with members from the Tehama County Child Protective Services arrived. During the subsequent investigation, it was learned that the infant's mother, Jessica Trimble (28 years of age), had caused the injury to the child during the morning hours of January 9, 2018. Both Trimble and the infant's father, Kenneth Keverline (31 years of age), knew the child was injured and medical attention wasn't sought until the following day.

The infant was placed into protective custody and is listed in stable condition.

The parents, Trimble and Keverline, were both booked into the Tehama County Jail. They were charged with child abuse and conspiracy. They are each being held in lieu of \$50,000.00 bail.
