SUMMARY:

On Sunday, January 8th, 2017 at 1037 hours, Red Bluff Dispatch received a 911 call regarding the sexual molestation of an 8 year old female.

During the course of the investigation, Detectives and Officers with Red Bluff Police Department learned 26 year old Jose Garcia had sexually assaulted the victim on more than one occasion within the past several weeks.

At approximately 1443 hours, Red Bluff Police Department Detectives located Garcia. With the assistance of the Tehama County Sheriff Deputies, Garcia was arrested at a residence in the Gerber area. Garcia was booked into the Tehama County Jail for the above listed charges and is being held on \$300,000.00 bail.

This case is still under investigation and no additional information will be released at this time.
