On Thursday, December 6, 2018 at 12:46 PM, Red Bluff Police Department Dispatch Center received a 911 call regarding a female that had wandered onto the campus of Lava Charter School, located on the 1600 block of Monroe Street. School staff advised the female was armed with a knife and was making irrational statements.

Red Bluff Police Officers responded to school, where school staff informed officers the female had been placed inside an empty classroom. The female, a 34-year-old Stockton resident was still armed with the knife when officers contacted her in the classroom. The female refused to relinquish the knife when ordered to do so by officers. Officers placed the school on lockdown while negotiating with the female. After several minutes the female relinquished the knife and was taken into protective custody for a mental health evaluation.

The Red Bluff Police Department would like to thank the staff at Lava Charter School for their quick response to this situation and would like the public to know that no students were in danger during this incident.
