On August 26<sup>th</sup>, 2017 at about 11:45 AM, a Corporal with the Red Bluff Police Department's Problem Oriented Policing Unit conducted an enforcement stop on a vehicle leaving the parking lot of the Vagabond Inn.

During the traffic stop the POP Unit and other Red Bluff Police Officers gained information of possible drug activity occurring at the Vagabond Inn. After completing the enforcement stop POP and other officers responded to the Vagabond Inn and spoke with the owners of the Inn.

As the investigation continued the POP unit and officers were directed to room #109 at the Inn. The room was rented by 30 year old Shannon Long of Red Bluff. Long was found to have an outstanding warrant out for her arrest. The POP Unit and Red Bluff Police Officers went to the room where they contacted Long and two other individuals inside the room. The two other individuals were identified as 52 year old Ricky Eusted of Red Bluff and 27 year old Mindi Garcia also of Red Bluff. Eusted was found to have a felony warrant out for his arrest for selling illicit narcotics. Eusted was detained and found to be in possession of a large amount of US Currency.

While inside the room, officers observed numerous items sitting in plain view that are consistent with the use and sales of illegal narcotics. During a consensual search of the room, officers located an ounce of Methamphetamine, approximately 9 grams of Heroin and other items consistent with the sales of narcotics.
