On January 10, 2017 at about 3:45 PM, Red Bluff Police Officers were dispatched to a residence on the 300 block of South Jackson Street regarding a possible residential burglary in progress. An alert citizen telephoned the police department regarding a suspicious male who was seen entering his neighbor's residence.

A Tehama County District Attorney Investigator was in the area and observed a male leaving the residence. The DA Investigator attempted to contact the male, who was later identified as 19 year old Samuel Paul (transient/ Red Bluff area). When the Investigator attempted to contact Paul, he fled on foot into a nearby apartment complex. A Red Bluff Police Officer and the Investigator pursued Paul. Paul was apprehended as he attempted to climb over a fence in the apartment complex.

Near where Paul was arrested, officers located a handgun. The subsequent investigation revealed that Paul had entered the victim's residence and stole the handgun along with some ammunition.

Paul was booked into the Tehama County Jail. Paul was charged with obstructing or delaying a peace officer and residential burglary.
