CRIME/INCIDENT: Residential Burglary, Possession of Burglary Tools, Possession of Narcotics and Resist/Delay Peace Officers.

ARREST DATE: April 13th, 2018

SUSPECT: Morrison, Dale 52 years old of Red Bluff

VICTIM: 16 year old juvenile

SUMMARY:

At approximately 1319 hours, Officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of Johnson Street regarding a residential burglary in progress. Further information was that the residence was occupied and that someone had smashed a glass door to make entry. Within minutes of the call, officers arrived on scene and quickly set up a perimeter around the home to prevent the suspect(s) escape. Moments later, a male adult, identified as 52 year old Dale Morrison, exited the residence through the front door and fled the area on foot. After a short foot chase, Morrison surrendered and was taken into custody without incident.

The teenage resident told officers that she had been home for just a few minutes when she heard the sound of glass breaking near her living room. She went to investigate and saw Morrison smash a glass door, which caused it to break. The juvenile quickly entered a bedroom for safety as she called police. Due to the vital information quickly obtained by Red Bluff Police Department dispatch and the quick response of officers, the juvenile was found unharmed and Morrison had no opportunity to commit other potentially serious crimes.

Morrison has an extensive criminal history and is well known to this department. He was taken to the Tehama County Jail where he was booked for burglary, possession of burglary tools, resist/delay peace officer and possession of narcotics. He is currently being held on \$109,000 bail.
