On January 29th, 2018 at about 5:28 PM, Red Bluff Police Officers were dispatched to a reported robbery involving a handgun in the parking lot of Wal-Mart. The caller, Amy Ball reported she and her husband, Cody Ball had been robbed at gunpoint by Dennis Paul Womack (24 year old Red Bluff resident) while in the parking lot of the store. Amy Ball advised the 911 operator that Womack was fleeing the parking lot in a black four door Honda Civic with a white female passenger inside.

Officers responded to the store and conducted an extensive search for Womack and the vehicle he was last seen driving. Neither Womack, nor the vehicle were located. Officers attempted to locate Amy and Cody Ball in the parking lot, but were unable to locate them at the time. Amy and Cody Ball had left the store and responded to the Red Bluff Police Department. Red Bluff Police Officers interviewed both Amy and Cody Ball regarding the robbery. Red Bluff Police Officers learned that Womack had asked to meet with the two in the parking lot of Wal-Mart regarding an unrelated issue. Amy and Cody Ball arrived at Wal-Mart and met with Womack in the parking lot. Womack walked up to Amy and Cody Ball's vehicle and demanded them to give him \$100.00 cash. Womack reportedly lifted the front of his shirt and exposed the handle of a handgun to both Amy and Cody Ball. Amy and Cody Ball gave Womack the money and Womack fled the scene moments later. Red Bluff Police Officers notified surrounding jurisdiction of the robbery and request Womack be arrested if located.

On Tuesday, January 30th, 2018 at 0700 hours, Red Bluff Police Departments Problem Oriented Policing Unit (POP) took over the investigation. POP Officers were able to track Womack to the Woodson Bridge RV Park, in Tehama County. POP Officers were informed that Womack had

learned officers were looking for him regarding the robbery. Womack responded to the Red Bluff Police Department where he turned himself into authorities. POP Officers interviewed Womack and arrested him for Robbery and a felony probation violation. Womack is currently being held without bail at the Tehama County Jail.
