CRIME/INCIDENT: *Train Vs. Pedestrian*

On July 24, 2017 at about 1017 AM, Red Bluff Police were dispatched to the area of the train tracks north of Oak Street between Madison Street and Monroe Street regarding a male subject laying near the tracks. It was reported the male did not have a pulse.

Red Bluff Officers located the male laying on the east side of the railroad tracks. CPR had been started by a citizen prior to law enforcement arrival. Officers relieved the citizen and continued administering CPR to the male.

During the investigation, it was learned the male had been struck by a passing train. It appears the male was crossing the railroad tracks from the west to the east when he was struck by the train. The male was pronounced deceased on scene.

The male is 53 years old from the Corning area. At this time the deceased individual's identity is being withheld pending next of kin notification.
