SUMMARY:

On August 7, 2016 at about 9:25 A.M.,

Officers from the Red Bluff Police Department were dispatched to the 800 block of Kimball Road regarding a stolen vehicle. Officer gathered the initial information regarding the case.

At about 2:41 P.M.,

Officers from the Red Bluff Police Department located the stolen vehicle driving eastbound on Oak Street approaching Jackson Street. When the officers attempted to make a traffic stop, the suspect fled the area at a high rate of speed. Officers pursued the stolen vehicle southbound on South Jackson Street until the suspect lost control of the vehicle and stopped in the driveway of a residence on the 1300 block of South Jackson Street.

The driver of the vehicle then fled on foot. Officers from the Red Bluff Police Department, Cal Fire Prevention, Deputies from the Tehama County Sheriff's Office, and California Highway Patrol Air Operations searched the area and located the suspect inside of Brookdale Senior Living located at 705 Luther Road.

The suspect had stolen some clothing from one resident in an attempt to conceal his identity. The suspect then locked himself in another resident's room and hid under the bed. Officers broke open the door and arrested the suspect who was identified as 26 year old Kevin Mair of Red Bluff. No one from Brookdale Senior Living was injured during this incident.

Mair was booked into the Tehama County Jail for 148(a)(1) PC - resisting arrest, 2800.2 CVC - evading a police officer, 459 PC - burglary, 496(d) PC - possession of stolen property, and 148.9(a) PC - false identify. Mair's bail was set at \$286,000.
